



- Centrally located and accessible by walking cycling or public transit
- Welcoming and inclusive
- Well maintained and activated

NEIGHBOUR HUBS SHOULD INCLUD

- Emergency resource storage
- Seating and gathering space
- Signage/community information/maps
- Natural elements / greenery
- Charging stations for devices
- Weather protection

- Annual painting party



1. HIVE Large


Hive large includes emergency storage, varying individual and group seating options, multiple tables and four planters.

2. **HIVE Medium**


The funky HIVE medium design includes emergency storage, comfortable reclined lounge chairs, two planters and varied-sized seating.

3. HIVE Small


Small but mighty, the HIVE small incorporates emergency storage, double seating with a table and an individual seat with a planter box.



Size Options

Kings Rd Neighbour Hub Recommendation

- Large HIVE Hub
- Replace current NAC parklet, set to expire in 2023
- Establish site stewardship & community programming



Next Steps

- 1. Hub Stewardship Grant
- Call of interest to NAC
- Opportunity to align with QVCC programs
- 2. Inform community of plan
- 3. Begin installation mid-October
